**RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING COINS-DROPS FOR
SWANTON VILLAGE.**

1. All coin-drops must follow state laws including rules regulated by the operation of motor vehicles, 23 V.S.A. § 1056. Section B.
2. Only not-for-profit organizations registered with the State of Vermont and municipal organizations are eligible to apply for a coin-drops within Swanton village. All eligible parties must receive approval by the Board of Trustees prior to conducting any coin-drop.
3. Release of liability and a Certificate of Insurance must be presented by the requesting organization to the village clerk one week prior to the approved coin-drop. The insurance certificates must specifically mention the activity of a coin drop and the dates to which the coin drop will occur.
4. The requesting organization will coordinate with the Swanton Village Police Chief regarding any safety issues. The requesting organization will coordinate with the public works' supervisor for the use of street signs and vests (if available). Swanton Village reserves the right to recall any borrowed equipment for use by the municipality. Any equipment borrowed from Swanton Village must be returned by the beginning of the next business day in the condition it was lent.
5. Coin-Drops will be held only through the months of May to October. No coin-drops will take place if it is raining, snowing, or if ice is present on the highway.
6. The Board of Trustee with input from the requesting organization will determine the date, hours, location and alternative rain date of the coin-drop.
7. The Board of Trustees reserves the right at any time to delay, suspend or cancel coin-drops for reasons concerning safety and the public good. All decisions regarding coin-drops are final and not grievable by the requesting organization.

TITLE 23

Motor Vehicles

CHAPTER 13. OPERATION OF VEHICLES

Subchapter V. Pedestrians' Rights and Duties

§ 1056. Highway solicitations

(b) Not-for-profit and municipal organizations may solicit contributions on the roadway of a highway, other than limited access highways, provided that approval is granted by the local legislative body, and the legislative body ensures that there is in effect a policy of liability insurance providing adequate coverage for the municipality. Approval shall not be granted by the local legislative body if the proposed activities or location would, in the judgment of the legislative body, create safety hazard or cause undue traffic congestion. No solicitations on the roadway may be done by any person under 16 years of age.
